
It's easy to learn how to uninstall a program from your computer, but learning how to do it properly is not as simple as following the steps outlined in another guide. You might end up paying for a program that slows down your machine or doesn't work properly because you didn't pay attention to the steps that came before. This article will show you why and how you should follow these particular steps and what they mean and ultimately how you should go about removing a program from your computer. This tutorial includes multiple screenshots of each step along with audio instruction through the entire process. If you are new to removing programs or just want a more visual approach, then this tutorial is the best choice. 1. Uninstall Program by clicking Start > Control Panel > Programs > Programs and Features > select the uninstall icon in the upper left corner of the program. 2. The next screen shows you which application is responsible for your problem. To find out what is causing the problem, click View Details on the right side of this window. If you see that there are other issues besides installing this program, then scroll down on that window to see what else may be causing problems with your computer. 3. If you want to uninstall a program from your computer, click Uninstall on the right side of the application. 4. The application will now ask if you want to uninstall from Windows or from your hard drive. The one thing that this step tells you is if the program's files are now deleted from your hard drive. If this action does not delete anything, then there is a problem with your machine and you'll need professional assistance before removing a program again. If the files are gone, then click Next to remove it from your machine. 5. Now you will need to choose if you want to restart your computer. The reason for this is that many programs are still running after the program is gone. If these running programs are not removed, then they can hang up your machine. If there are no programs that are not closed, then click No to proceed. Also, if you do not want to restart now, click Yes and close the windows by clicking the X in the upper corner, so you can proceed with uninstalling other applications or optimizing your machine without having to go through this process again immediately by following steps 1-5 again. 6. Now that your computer is rebooted you should check again to see if the program is still installed on your machine. If you do not see the program installed on your machine, then you can now move on to fixing any problems that were caused by the program you just uninstalled.
